

# Short Course Meters NC records and Top 10

The SCM season ends December 31st. Although the number of SCM meets is small, a fair amount of NC SCM records has been broken this year. For details check the update of the NC SCM records that recently has been posted on our LMSC web site.

The table below summarizes the new 2013 SCM records. A total of 49 new records were set: 27 by the women, 19 by the men and 3 relay records. There were four world records set, two by Erika Brown and two by relay teams. The relay world records were by Sue Walsh, Jen Stringer, Alicia Uhl, and Erika Braun for the 200 free relay in the 160-199 age group, and by Francis Mc Eachran, Jon Blank, Erika Braun, and Jon Klein in the 200 Medley in the 200-239 age group.
