In addition to the USMS coaches, the camp includes sports science, sports nutrition, and sports psychology geared towards individual camp participants. In-pool training, classroom education, individual videos of campers' strokes above and below the water surface, and in-person perspectives from Masters Olympians are all part of the program.
